



The strategic plan was developed with the extensive involvement of the organization's internal and external stakeholders.

The CMHA Peel Dufferin 2016-2019 Strategic Plan is the result of consultations and discussions with a number of individuals and groups, including individuals with lived experience of mental illnesses and addictions, clinicians and mental health workers, families and community partners. This plan is a reflection of the knowledge and insights of those who shared their experiences with us.

This Strategic Plan reinforces our Mission & our over 50-year history of bringing better mental health to our community. It builds on our commitment to providing equitable access to quality mental health services that support individuals in their recovery. This plan also reinforces our goal to increase awareness of mental health, reduce the stigma associated with mental illness and move us closer to the goal of mental health for all.

Three key priorities for community mental health and addictions emerged from the process: Enhanced access to services closer to home, a continuum of mental health and addictions services and workforce development that is focussed on quality and innovation.
